The first day of school is Wednesday, August 23. Parents are welcome to attend the assembly conducted by the Student Council at

8am. Students are to be in school uniform.

Generally speaking, classroom doors open at 7:50am. Students arriving before the 7:50am bell will be directed to extended care.



The tardy bell rings at 8am and gates are then locked. Parents are asked to accompany their student to the office to sign in the tardy book.

For students in grades K-8, there will be a 12pm dismissal Wednesday, August 23, Thursday, August 24 and Friday, August 25.

Friday, August 25 is our first All School Liturgy at 8am and students are to be in dress uniform. **Please make every effort to get students to school in time to walk over to the church with their classmates.**

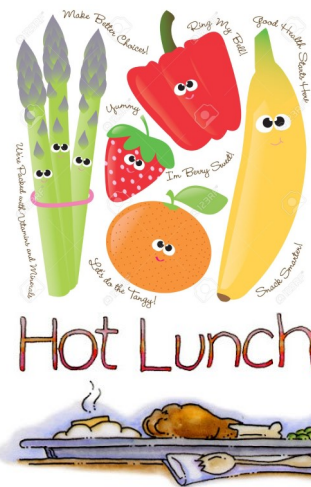

Parents are welcome to join the student body for the end of the week send-off prayer (Fridays at 2:35pm; 11:50am on noon dismissal days, 12:50pm on early release days). Refer to the calendar.

If you do plan to join the HT community, please park in the parking lot off of Ballard in front of the school office and enter through the gate between the office and the faculty room. After prayer, students may leave with you from the same gate.

We want to keep all "foot traffic" entering and exiting limited to the front of the school. The carline procedure will remain the same for parents choosing to wait out back for dismissal. The back gate will not be open until the bell rings indicating the end of the day.



**Please provide healthy snacks for your student for breaktime and after school if attending extended care or sports practices.**

**Remember to pack a lunch for your student and include plastic utensils, if necessary.**

**Hot lunch begins September 5. A hard copy of the hot lunch menu will be provided at Back to School Night, Monday, August 21 (due by 1pm Wednesday, August 30).**

**One menu per student. Lunch purchases will be posted in the classroom for your student to refer to. In the primary grades, teachers often announce daily who has hot lunch. We do not have hot lunch on 12pm dismissal days.**

**Please make sure your student has a refillable water bottle daily!**



**Label lunch bags, water bottles, uniforms, and backpacks clearly with your student's name.**

We do not have water bottles on hand nor do we want the students to rely on the school to provide them.

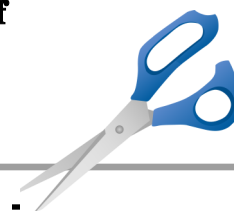
