The Seventh Graders will be leading this Parish/School Mass. Students are to be in full dress uniform. Students are not to use non-uniform

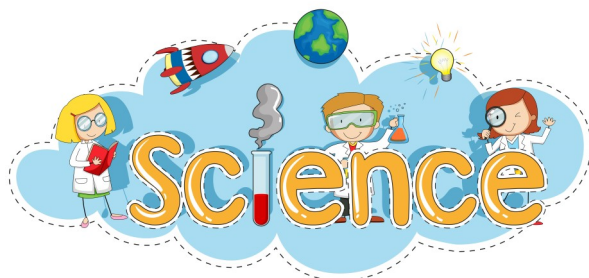
free dress coupons on Mass days. If a student's birthday falls on a Mass day, they may wear free dress the day before OR after.

in support of breast cancer awareness. Non participating students must be in school uniform.



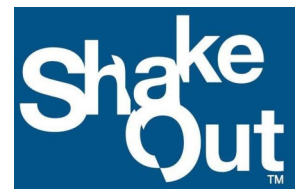
Curriculum Family Day (Grades K-8)

This year's **International Shake Out Day** is Thursday, **October 19.**

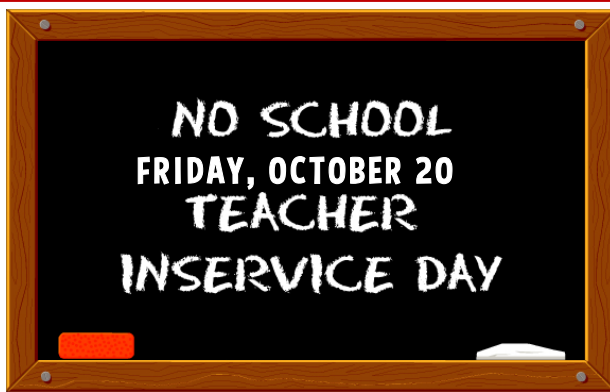
