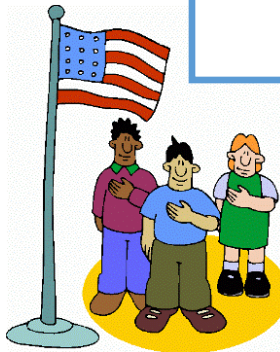

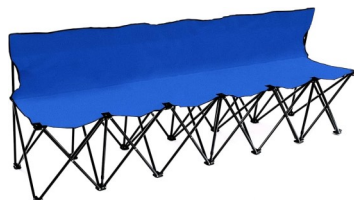
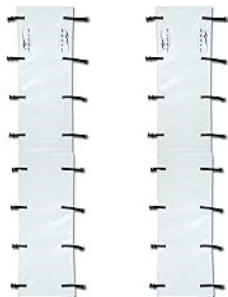

MULTICULTURAL DAY

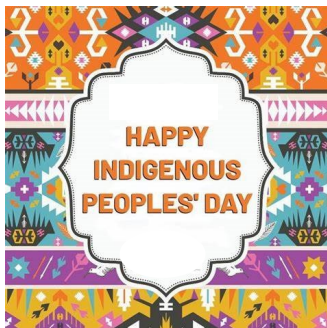


Friday, October 6 | 1pm

Blessing of the Animals-Tuesday, October 3 at 2:30pm

Families who wish to have their pet receive a blessing must walk their pets on a leash (no longer than 6 ft.) or cage immediately on campus at 2:30pm for the blessing. Due to the nature of animals in new situations **animals must be under the constant control of parents or guardians at all times.** Some pets can be aggressive or hostile in new situations. Please understand the age of our school children and do not bring aggressive or hostile animals for their safety. Students must remain seated at their designate lunch table with their teacher and class, unless their parent or guardian is present for the blessing. Students **may not** handle the pets by themselves. Please refer to the map attached electronically today for more details on the areas designated for parents and their pets.

If you are unable to bring your family pet, please send your child to school with a picture of your beloved family pet that Fr. Rey can bless.
