A Blessing Prayer for Those Who Are Sick

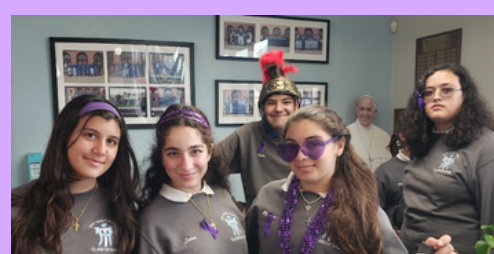



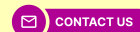
