

## 5 Things Parents Need to Know Today!

- 4. **SD Catholic Mother's Day Video** Just a friendly reminder that tomorrow is the last day to submit any photos! The diocese is collecting pictures of children holding a flower, an image of our Lady, holding a sign that says Happy Mother's Day, I Love You, etc. in different languages. Please ensure that you have permission to share these pictures. They will be listed on our Diocesan website, social media outlets and the diocesan YouTube Channel. Details: 1) The pictures need to be from the waist up.
