



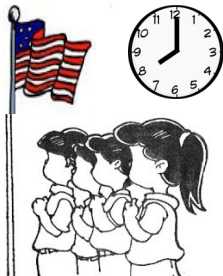
All School Mass

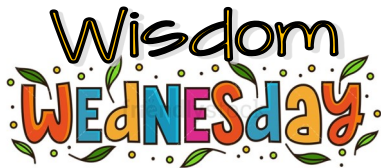


Mrs. Marentez Message & the Covid-19 Resources from SD HHSA will be emailed tomorrow.

STATIONS of the CROSS

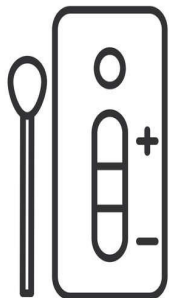


Attention Parents of Eighth Graders:

We have "at home" Covid-19 rapid tests available!



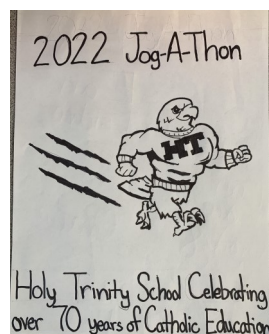

Jog-A-Thon 2022



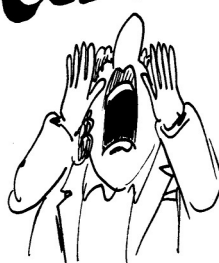

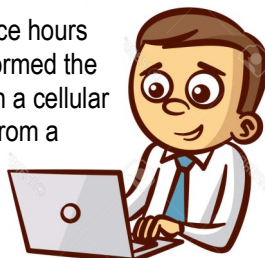

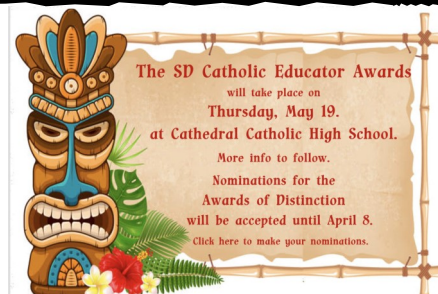
