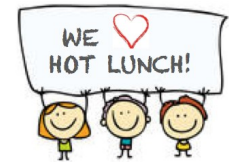
There will be no school Monday, September 7 in celebration of Labor Day. Tuesday, September 8 will be the first full day of school. Please make sure your student has a lunch.



Parental supervision at lunchtime will NOT be allowed this year due to Covid-19. **We strongly discourage lunch drop off and phone calls from 11:50am —12:40pm as office staff will be occupied with lunch supervision.** Teachers will have lunch with their classes either in the classroom or outside.



- ⇒ It is our hope to have the “hot lunch” program up and running some time this month. Be on the lookout for the order form.
- ⇒ Due to Covid-19, we ask that parents not enter campus before or after school. Only one parent/family at a time will be allowed in the office for school business.
- ⇒ Please inform the school office of a student absence and request homework ASAP, if you’d like. Homework requests must be received no later than 8:30am.
- ⇒ **AT ALL TIMES DURING DISTANCE LEARNING:** Students must wear uniform tops and sit at an appropriate desk/table/workspace during distance learning and follow student expectations for virtual learning.
- ⇒ This year will be a transition year as far as uniforms go. While we are phasing out skorts, white dress shirts, and green PE t-shirts, students will be allowed to wear them for the 2020-21 school year. These items are no longer available through Dennis Uniform or Used Uniform.
Shoes must be ALL black.
 Girls may wear black rubber soled Mary Janes on non PE days.



An update from CDC regarding face shields

Face Coverings

Students

Age	Face Covering Requirement
Under 2 years old	No
2 years old - 2nd grade	Strongly Encouraged
3rd grade - High school	Yes, unless exempt

Staff

All staff must use face coverings in accordance with CDPH guidelines unless Cal/OSHA standards require respiratory protection.

Students may remove mask coverings when seated behind the plexiglass shields at their desk. Please provide your child with a small plastic container to place their mask covering when not being worn (i.e. behind plexiglass and while eating snack/lunch).

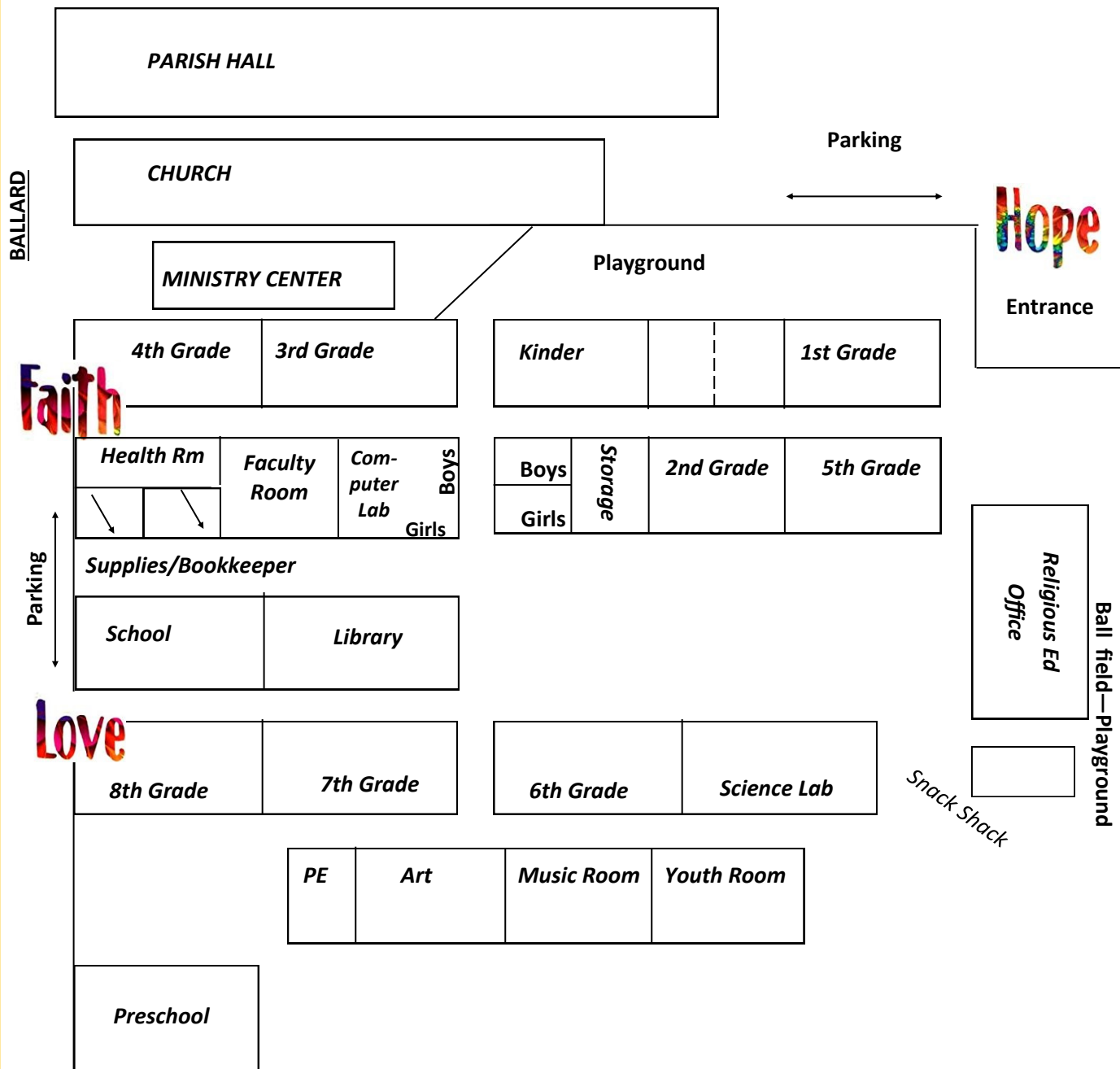
A clear face shield with drape coverings may be used in place of a face covering when it is necessary for a person’s face to be visible during interactions.

For families with multiple children, please use the gate assigned to your youngest child.

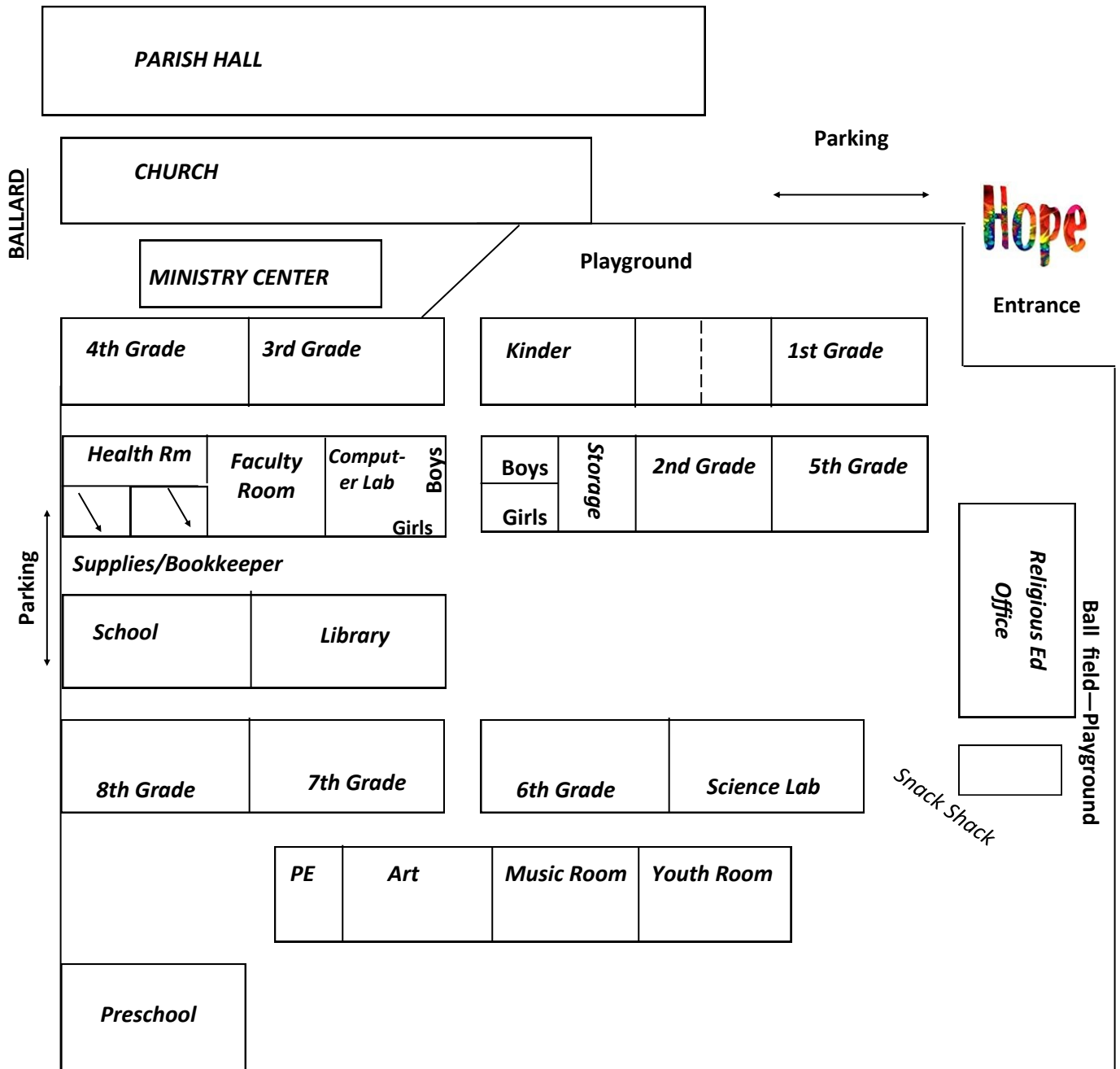
After School Car Line Pick-Up

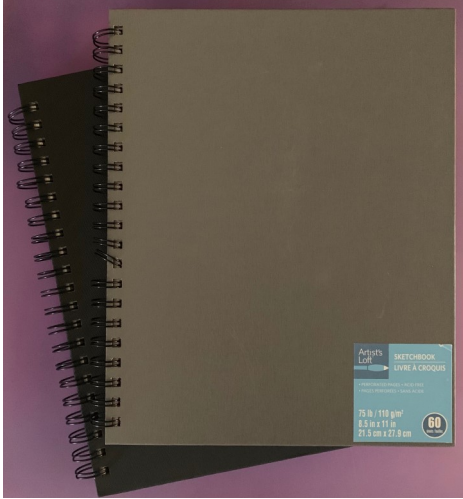

Morning daycare will be available in the science room from 7-7:45am with Mrs. Noble. Parents will drop off students at the “LOVE” gate where Mrs. Ray will do a symptom and temperature check. Parents must wait for a verbal okay from Mrs. Ray before leaving. Students can then walk over to the science room.

After school daycare will also be held in the science room. Students not picked up at the appropriate time, will be signed in by Miss Patsy. Parents must call the school and wait at the “LOVE” gate for their children. There will be a sign-out book at the gate where parents can note the time and Miss Patsy will do the same in the daycare room.

Snacks/water are not provided at daycare.

Daycare is \$4 per hour per student—\$200 maximum per month per student. After school time is charged beginning at dismissal with a minimum charge of one hour/\$4.

We follow the regular school calendar. There will be no after school daycare on the last school day before Christmas and Easter break, and the last day of school.

Students will remain in same cohort with social distancing.
