Today is also the deadline for the Father-Daughter dance to be held Friday, May 6.

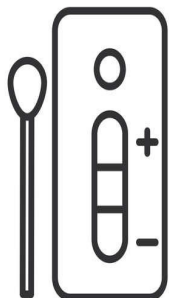

Do you have a singer in the family? The April Choir Sign-Up flyer can be found in today's Parent Envelope. Choir is for students in Grades K-8.

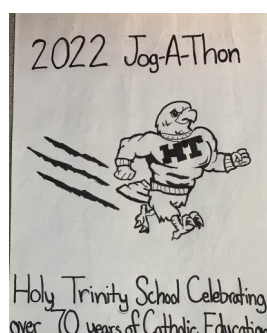


Catholic Schools' Night at Petco Friday, May 27
