## First Sunday of advent: November 28



The first candle on the Advent wreath is called the Candle of Prophecy. It reminds us of how God spoke to His people through the prophets, offering them the hope of a Savior. It also reminds us of the faithfulness of God's promises, so that we can live in hope.

### On the First Sunday in Advent

- Light one purple candle (the one opposite the pink candle)
- Read Isaiah 60:2-3 Lord God, we light this candle to thank you for your Son our Savior Jesus Christ, who is the light of the world. We who have sat in darkness have seen a great light, the light of Jesus Christ, our salvation. We give you thanks and praise in Jesus' name, because He lives and reigns with you in your glory, and in the unity of the Holy Spirit, Amen.


