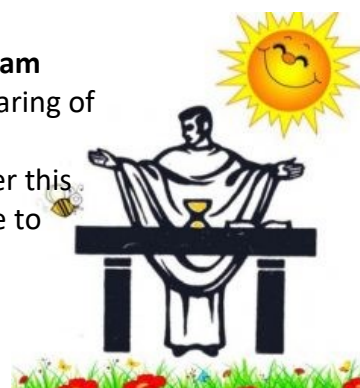

PARISH BREAKFAST



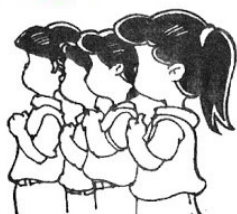
(The next Parish Breakfast will be held Sunday, January 30 with Grades 3, 4, 5 in charge.)
